India has a huge backlog of cataract, many patients have delay in the presentation of both cataract and glaucoma to the hospital, mainly due to lack of awareness and financial issues. Our team in a tertiary care center has been carrying out screening eye camps at a nearby village. The camp approach allows for a large number of patients (600 and above) to be educated and made aware, while also being screened for cataract and glaucoma. Through the year, we get a steady stream of patients from the rural areas surrounding the camp who were screened in the camp. Free PCIOLs are provided. Glaucoma investigations are done for those who are labelled as glaucoma suspects in the screening process. The role of the free eye camp is still extremely valuable in India. We will educate about the technique of screening in an eye camp and its usefulness through this instruction course, so that the uneducated/ poor patients will not have the risk of losing their vision.
